PRODUCT: Coopex Insect Powder. High 

1	TRADE NAME	Coopex Insect Powder
2	ACTIVE INGREDIENT	Permethrin 0.5%
3	PURPOSE	A ready to use insecticidal dust for crawling insects and wasp nests.
4	APPEARANCE	White powder
5	HAZARD	Hazardous by ingestion avoid contact with mouth and skin
6	HANDLING / USAGE	Cover all foodstuffs before application. Protect food preparing equipment and kitchen utensils from contamination during application. Do not apply to surfaces on which food is stored, prepared or eaten. Do not apply directly to pets and animals. Remove excess dust from treated fabrics and air thoroughly before use. Remove fish bowls and cover fish tanks before dusting. Read the label before use.
7	MIXING	Do not mix. Ready to use dust.
8	APPLICATION	Apply through dust applicator. Ensure all application equipment is free from other pesticide dust before use. Check seals on equipment before use.
9	RESTRICTIONS	Dust not to come into direct contact with processed food or food preparation surfaces. Dust to be placed in areas away from non-target animals and young children. Dust not to be placed in areas where there is a reasonable likelihood that a rodent might, after walking through it, transfer quantities of dust to work surfaces or on to prepared food.
10	PPE	Overalls, synthetic rubber gloves, goggles
11	RPE	Respirator fitted with a P3 filter
12	ROUTES OF ABSORPTION	
13	WEL (workplace exposure limit)	Not on EH40 List.
14	FIRST AID MEASURES	Eyes: Rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. Inhalation: Remove to fresh air and seek medical advice if there is more than trivial exposure. Skin: Wash off immediately with plenty of soap and water Ingestion: Wash out mouth, give plenty of water.
15	FIRE	Use foam and dry agent. Do not use water because of risk of water course contamination.
16	STORAGE	Store in original container. Lids must be tightly fitted. If decanted, container must be labelled. Product must only be stored in a PESTPROOF vehicle or PESTPROOF approved stores.
17	TRANSPORT	Product must be transported in the pesticide storage area of company van or in a sealed container. Container must have lid fitted and be secured to avoid spillage. Container must be carried in specialist's holdall and not left unattended at any time.
18	SPILLAGE	Sweep up minimising dust evolution and transfer to closed container for disposal. Do not contaminated ponds, ditches or waterways with the product or used containers
19	WASTE DISPOSAL	Remove and dispose of in accordance with company procedures for the disposal of waste pesticide. Dispose of as hazardous waste in accordance with local regulations.
