1	TRADE NAME	Ficam D
2	ACTIVE INGREDIENT	Bendiocarb 1%
3	PURPOSE	For the control of insect pests
4	APPEARANCE	Dust
5	HAZARD	Toxic by inhalation and if swallowed. Dangerous for the environment.
6	HANDLING / USAGE	Do not breathe dust, wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using. Do not apply to surfaces where food is stored, prepared or eaten. Protect food and equipment from contamination during used. Do not apply directly to animals. Remove excess dust and air treated fabric thoroughly. Extinguish all naked flames, including pilot lights when using. Do not apply to unprotected electrical equipment. Read the label before use.
7	MIXING	Ready to use product. Do not mix.
8	APPLICATION	Apply through dust applicator. Ensure all application equipment is free from other pesticide dust before use. Check seals on equipment before use.
9	RESTRICTIONS	Do not use on clothing and bedding
10	PPE	Gloves, Overalls, Goggles
11	RPE	Suitable respirator
12	ROUTES OF ABSORPTION	Ingestion, Inhalation
13	WEL (workplace exposure limit)	Not on EH40 List.
14	FIRST AID MEASURES	Contains anticholinesterase carbamate insecticide. Recommended antidote is atropine sulphate. Do not use pralidoxime. Eyes - Rinse immediately with water for fifteen minutes and obtain medical attention. Inhalation - Remove to fresh air and obtain medical attention. Support respiration if necessary. Skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Ingestion - If swallowed, wash out mouth with water, keep patient at rest and obtain medical attention immediately. Do not give patient anything to eat or drink.
15	FIRE	Do not breathe dust or fumes. Extinguish fires with water, although foam, carbon dioxide or dry powder may be used. Fire fighters should wear self contained breathing apparatus.
16	STORAGE	Store in original container. Replace lid tightly after use. If decanted, container must be labelled. Product must only be stored in a PESTPROOF LTD vehicle or in the PESTPROOF LTD stores.
17	TRANSPORT	Product must be transported in the pesticide storage area of company van or in a sealed container. Container must have lid fitted and be secured to avoid spillage. Product must be carried in service specialist's holdall and not left unattended at any time.
18	SPILLAGE	Wear PPE. Decontaminate protective clothing or otherwise dispose of as contaminated
19	WASTE DISPOSAL	Remove and dispose of in accordance with company procedures for the disposal of waste pesticide. Dispose of as hazardous waste in accordance with local regulations.
