

## COSHH ASSESSMENT. Hazard Level

PRODUCT: Phostoxin. High 

1	TRADE NAME	Phostoxin
2	ACTIVE INGREDIENT	Aluminium Phosphide – 56%
3	PURPOSE	For the use of control of rodents, rabbits and moles outdoors.
4	APPEARANCE	Grey Green tablets with ammonical odour. Supplied in stoppered aluminium flask containing 30 tablets.
5	HAZARD	Hazardous by inhalation avoid contact with skin and mouth. Tablet dissolves on contact with moisture and gives off phosphine gas.
6	HANDLING / USAGE	Do not use in wet weather. To be used only by an operator trained in the use of aluminium phosphide. Open container out doors.
7	MIXING	Ready to use
8	APPLICATION	After carefully surveying the area to be treated, apply the correct number of tablets directly into the burrow or run recommended 2 tablets per run or burrow. Do not re-seal containers once a container has been opened all tablets within the respective container should be used.
9	RESTRICTIONS	Product can only be used in an area at least 5 – 10 mtrs away from buildings
10	PPE	Overalls, safety shoes, synthetic rubber gloves, safety goggles,
11	RPE	Respiratory equipment and visor
12	ROUTES OF ABSORPTION	Ingestion, Skin, Inhalation, Eyes
13	WEL (workplace exposure limit)	Not on EH40 List.
14	FIRST AID MEASURES	<b>Ingestion:</b> induce vomiting. Seek medical advice immediately <b>Skin:</b> There will be irritation and redness <b>Eyes:</b> There will be irritation and redness. <b>Inhalation:</b> Remove to fresh air immediately. Seek medical advice as a precaution.
15	FIRE	Use water spray, alcohol resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. Use high volume water jet. Evolution of dangerous gasses is possible, do not breathe fumes. Wear self contained breathing apparatus for fire fighting if necessary.
16	STORAGE	Keep containers tightly closed in a cool, well ventilated place. Store in a place accessible by authorised persons only. Keep away from direct sunlight and protect against frost.
17	TRANSPORT	Product should be transported only in <b>PESTPROOF LTD</b> company vehicles in the original lidded container. Product must be secured to avoid spillage.
18	SPILLAGE	Wear suitable protective clothing and boots. Absorb with sand or other inert material and transfer to a closed container for disposal. Do not contaminate drains or sewers with product or used containers.
19	WASTE DISPOSAL	Arrange for chemical incineration or properly supervised removal by an approved waste contractor.
