1	TRADE NAME	Sorex Gel
2	ACTIVE INGREDIENT	Difenacoum 0.005%, Bitrex
3	PURPOSE	Rodenticide
4	APPEARANCE	A semi – solid green paste
5	HAZARD	Very Toxic by inhalation, contact with skin and if swallowed. Dangerous to the environment and aquatic organisms.
6	HANDLING / USAGE	Avoid all contact by mouth, wash hands and exposed skin before eating, drinking or smoking and after work. Do not lay bait where food, feed or water could not become contaminated. Place baits only in situations where there is no ready access to occupants of houses. Apply product using a skeleton or caulking gun. Read the label before use.
7	MIXING	Ready to use product. DO NOT MIX
8	APPLICATION	Apply using a caulking gun.
9	RESTRICTIONS	N/A
10	PPE	Disposable Gloves and Overalls
11	RPE	Respiratory equipment to be used only if exceeding WEL.
12	ROUTES OF ABSORPTION	None
13	WEL (workplace exposure limit)	Not on EH40 List.
14	FIRST AID MEASURES	Eyes: Wash out immediately by irrigating the eye for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical advice if necessary. Skin: Wash skin with soap and water. Inhalation: Remove patient from exposure and into fresh air immediately Ingestion: Do Not induce vomiting, rinse out mouth and seek medical attention if necessary. Antidote: VITAMIN K1
15	FIRE	This product is non-flammable, but is combustible. Use water spray, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. Cool smoldering material with water spray to minimise the possibility of re-ignition. Keep containers and surroundings cool with water spray. Wear self contained breathing apparatus.
16	STORAGE	Store in original container. If decanted, container must be labelled. Product must only be stored in PESTPROOF LTD vehicle or PESTPROOF LTD stores.
17	TRANSPORT	Product must be transported in the pesticide storage area of company van or in a sealed container. Container must have lid fitted and be secured to avoid spillage. Container must be carried in specialist's holdall and not left unattended at any time.
18	SPILLAGE	Any spillages should be cleared up immediately and disposed of safely. Wash contaminated surfaces with detergent solution.
19	WASTE DISPOSAL	Remove and dispose of in accordance with company procedures for the disposal of waste rodenticide. Must be disposed of as controlled waste.
